1	<p><b>TITLE</b></p> <p>In this module we discuss proofs of the 3 deadly virtues.</p>
2	<p>Summary of False Christ-Like Love ... From Mother Teresa's own words.</p> <p>Anim1: Quote Mother Teresa</p> <p>Anim2: Quote Mother Teresa</p>
3	<p><b>Philosophical proof</b></p> <p>* Here is the recipe for how to corrupt love in 3 simple steps</p> <p>* Take the words "I Love You."</p> <p>Anim1: Eliminate the "I" from "I Love You"...How?</p> <p>Anim2: Introduce Selflessness...Remove the self from the equation.</p> <p>Anim3: Now let's Eliminate the "You" from "I love You"...How?</p> <p>Anim4: Introduce Unconditional Love...Unconditional love has nothing to do with anyone.</p> <p>Anim5: Now let's eliminate the concept of love itself, turning it into sacrificial, duty laden relationship."...How?</p> <p>Anim6: Introduce Self-Sacrifice...Love is no longer recognizable as love, because it has now become "I sacrifice myself for you".</p> <p>Anim7: So all 3 taken together...</p> <p>Anim8: "I Love You" becomes...</p> <p>This unconditional, selfless, self-sacrificial love becomes an all-powerful god in itself. It becomes a universal "get-out-of-jail-free" card for anyone to do anything and get away with it as long as they claim it is love. It takes over everything it touches, becoming a law unto itself thanks to DUTY ETHICS....</p>
4	<p><b>Existential Proof: Tulips</b></p> <p>Anim1: Tulips have specific life requirements which demand constant care such as:</p> <p>Anim2: Sunshine</p> <p>Anim3: Water</p> <p>Anim4: And Minerals</p>
5	<p>Let's apply the 3 Deadly Virtues to the tulips in an existential proof and see what happens:</p> <p>Anim: Starting with <b>Selflessness</b>, you must forget about the patch of earth your life requires.</p> <p>* You must selflessly invite others to take up your space. But not just any "others".</p> <p>* Your Duty is to invite THE MOST NEEDY others...Dandelions (weeds) to come share your space.</p>
6	<p>Next, with <b>Self-Sacrifice</b>, when the rain comes, you must give it all away (remember "give said the little stream").</p> <p>* Duty requires that you give away NO MATTER WHAT or WHO the others are (i.e. weeds).</p> <p>Anim: Umbrella over tulip...and the weeds grow.</p>
7	<p>* Finally, apply <b>Unconditional Love</b>.</p> <p>* John 15:13 "Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends." (only...they are not your friends)</p> <p>* You must love all these poor Dandelion creatures "NO MATTER WHAT", especially to the point of giving up your life for them.</p> <p>* The fact that they have taken over your space, and sucked up all of the water, just gives you all the more chance to prove that your unconditional Love.</p>

	<p>* In the end, the Tulip is gone, the garden has become a patch of overgrown weeds...Worthy of being burned.  <b>If the three deadly virtues consistently applied will do that to your garden...What will they do to your life?</b></p>
8	<p><b>Existential Proof: Convenience Store</b>  <b>Anim1:</b> Apply Selflessness to the convenience store...          * Instead of worrying about building a business for the purpose of maintaining your own life and livelihood, you worry only about selfless-service to those who come in.          * As the owner you stay open 24/7 even if no customers come by. You forget about closing on holidays, family events, etc. and work 24/7 living just to serve others.</p> <p><b>Anim2:</b> Next, apply self-sacrifice. It is not enough just to break even, you cannot make a profit. In fact, you must lose money by giving stuff away (give said the little stream), otherwise you are being selfish.</p> <p><b>Anim3:</b> Next, to show your unconditional Love, you invite everyone ... Friends, thieves, and competitors to come loot your shelves.          * Remember: worthy or unworthy doesn't matter when it comes to unconditional love.</p> <p><b>If the three deadly virtues consistently applied will do that to your Convenience Store...          What will they do to your life?</b></p>
9	<p><b>Existential Proof: Nuclear Power Plant</b>          Welcome to your new job offer working for the Value Ethics Power Plant          Let's go through your list of employee benefits that will be your compensation for working here.  <b>Anim1:</b> Annual salary: 20% above average salary in the surrounding area due to your specific technical expertise.  <b>Anim2:</b> Annual Bonus: 15% of annual salary as an incentive to keep excellent workers like yourself from leaving to work for competitors.  <b>Anim3:</b> Strong work Ethic by co-workers, high morale, low turnover due to excellent company profit margins and well-defined performance criteria  <b>Anim4:</b> Uncompromising Safety Standards.  <b>Anim5:</b> Rigorous background checks for all Employees. Only Highly Qualified applicants get work here.  <b>Anim6:</b> Great profit margins, great projections for next year. <b>You take the job.</b></p> <p>In the 1st quarter of the new year, a new governing body "<b>Duty Ethics Inc.</b>" takes over and starts implementing new "ethically ideal" policies.  <b>Anim7:</b> 1st Quarter (<b>Selflessness Policy</b>)...In order to forget about ourselves and put others first, we must sell energy at cost, freeze wages, and remove all employee bonus incentives. Consequently, all expansion plans are no longer feasible.</p> <p><b>Anim8:</b> 2nd Quarter (<b>Self-Sacrifice Policy</b>)....In order to show proper sacrificial love to others, we will now sell energy below cost. In order to sustain this effort, we must have a series of layoffs, and wage cuts. ... Give away said the little stream.</p> <p><b>Anim9:</b> 3rd Quarter (<b>Unconditional Love</b> and <b>Non-Judgmentalism Policy</b>)...Because we must love everyone "no matter what or who" we remove all hiring standards and drop all employee performance measurements for those employees who still remain.          * We also initiate a "love your enemies" quota of hiring 1 terrorist per 100 employees.</p>
10	<p>4th Quarter Projections...  <b>If the three deadly virtues consistently applied will do that to your Power Plant...          What will they do to your life?</b></p>
11	<p><b>Existential Proof: Parenthood.</b></p>

	<p>To prove that you really believe in these three deadly virtues, make sure that your daughter takes them with her on her first date...</p> <p>Anim1: Quote  Anim2: Would parents who believe in 3 deadly virtues actually be willing to let their daughter out of the house? Yet consider the ideal attitude, and victim mentality as stated by Mother Teresa.  Anim3: Quote Mother Teresa</p> <p>If the 3 deadly virtues don't work in real life (Flower Bed, Convenience Store, Power Plant, Parenthood, etc.) why does traditional Christianity continue to advocate them?  How did Traditional Christianity get there?</p>
12	<p>Take the phrase: <b>Wickedness never was happiness.</b></p> <p>Anim1: In Value Ethics this means you renounce wickedness to gain happiness  Anim2: From a True Ideology perspective, Wickedness and Happiness are not compatible.</p> <p>Anim3: From a Duty Ethics perspective one turns the phrase on its head...Happiness has nothing to do with Righteousness.  Anim4: The thought being that one must renounce happiness for righteousness demands.  Anim5: This is where the False Ideology comes in...That Righteousness and Happiness are not compatible.</p> <p>Anim6: The "bait and switch" comes from this overlap in the word "Happiness"...  The promise of Happiness and then Duty Ethics takes it away, overshooting the mark into absolutism.</p>
13	<p>Let's rewind before the "Bait and Switch" and take a closer look</p> <p>Anim1: If Happiness is the ultimate end  Anim2: Then Righteousness is not an END in itself (a Duty), but a MEANS used to achieve eternal happiness.  Anim3: Value Ethics has no "Bait and Switch".</p> <p>But don't we believe in doing our Duty?</p>
14	<p>It is called "The Great Plan of Happiness"...not "The Great Plan of Duty, Love, etc."</p> <p>Anim1: Quote Joseph Smith ... Notice the conditional IF  Anim2: Quote Joseph Smith  Anim3: Quote John Taylor ... Notice the conditional OUGHT  Anim4: Quote Boyd K. Packer ... Notice the conditional IF</p> <p>Happiness sums up Everything we have been talking about...Great plan of happiness, not the great plan of love, duty, etc.</p>
